- ✓ The East and West Coast will be divided at Gander, with Gander included in the West Coast Category.
- ✓ Exceptions may be permitted upon submission of written requests sent to the office for executive approval.
- ✓ All tournaments will be grade based. Teams and athletes are able to play in a higher grade tournament.
- ✓ Individuals and teams cannot play in a lower grade tournament.
- ✓ The NLBA office and the minor committee will decide which teams go to the "A", "B" or "C" events.
- ✓ There will be sanctions and / or fines for teams that withdraw from an event after it starts.
- ✓ By entering any of these events, coaches agree to abide by the rules of the NLBA

**Important Information and Notes:** (Please Read)

**REGISTRATION FEE:**

**\$130.00 for Grade 4 – 3 on3** boys’ and girls’ tournaments,

**\$364.00 for Grade 5 and Grade 6** boys’ and girls’ tournaments,

**ALL other tournaments \$390.00** payable to NLBA (must accompany form).

- ✓ For refund, please see the rules booklet. Please note, teams who drop out after the schedule is completed, must pay the appropriate registration fee, and will not receive a refund.

**NEW DEADLINES:**

**January 10, 2018 for the Grades 4, 5 and 6** – Applications must be in provincial office.

**January 31, 2018 for the Grades 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11** – Applications must be in provincial office.

*Applications will not be accepted unless accompanied by fees.*

The NLBA office and the minor committee will determine which teams go to the “A”, “B” or “C” events.

- Back of applications must be complete with mailing addresses, postal codes, birth dates, phone numbers, and emails at least 14 days prior to the tournament!
- There is no need to place a formal protest for ineligible players. The game is automatically defaulted. Opposing team wins by 20-0 score.

3. **Man-to-man defense:** – in grades 5 and 6, only man to man defense is permitted. As a one-year pilot project the NLBA will permit zone defense to be played at grade 7 and above. At the end of the year the NLBA will seek feedback as to whether teams will continue to be permitted to play zone at these levels.

4. **Grade 5 rule adjustments:** – This will be for a one-year pilot program.

- a. **Game time:** Change to reflect 6 stop time periods of 5 minutes each. **No power shift.** Games should resume as quickly as possible at the ends of periods 1, 2, 4 and 5. Coaches will not be given the opportunity to address the next line before the start of the period. Each line should be ready to resume the game within 15 to 20 seconds of the final buzzer for the preceding period. Coaches should address their oncoming line on the bench prior to the end of the preceding period. There will be a 5-minute halftime between the end of period 3 and the start of period 4.
- b. **Score sheets:** Coaches, depending on team size, will designate 2 or 3 line-ups who will alternate during the 6 periods. Players designated on line 1 must play in periods 1 and 4, or in periods 1, 3 and 5. Players designated on line 2 must play in periods 2 and 5, or in periods 2, 4 and 6. Only if a coach has 15 or more players they must designate a third line who will play in periods 3 and 6. Subs are also assigned to a specific line if a coach has between 11 and 14 players or more than 15.
- c. **Substitutions:** In the case where a team has just 10 players, and a player is injured or fouled out the team can designate a replacement player for each remaining shift as long as no player plays more than 4 shifts. The coach must write the name and number of the substitute player for the current shift and who must substitute on any remaining shifts. Once designated this cannot change.
- d. **Time outs:** 1 time out per team per period. One time out for each overtime period.
- e. **Penalty:** Teams will shoot bonus on the 8<sup>th</sup> team foul of each half.

5. **Personal fouls:** For grades 5 – 7 players will have 5 personal fouls per game.
